

MOULD AND MILDEW WASH

Fungicidal Inhibitor

Description

A premium grade mould and mildew wash specially formulated to remove mould, mildew, moss and lichen and actively discourage re-growth of such fungi.

Uses

For removing mould, mildew, moss and lichen from walls, roofs and floors of all types both externally as well as internally.

Application

Gloves, overalls and goggles should be worn at all times when handling this product. Ensure all loose growths are first removed using a stiff brush. Apply two coats of Bond It **MOULD AND MILDEW WASH** at the rate of 10m² per litre using a low pressure spray (non-atomising) or brush ensuring care is taken to brush the wash thoroughly into any cracks or crevices and allowing 24 hours to stand.

Cleaning of Tools

All equipment used should be rinsed thoroughly with plenty of water.

Limitations

If the surface is going to be treated with any other product, e.g. Bond It WATERSEAL, SILICONE ULTRA WATERSEAL or BITUBOND roofing products, then the surface should be washed first with water and left to dry out before applying any of these products.

Storage Conditions

Store in cool, dry conditions in a sealed container. Protect from frost, high temperature and direct sunlight.

Shelf Life

Up to 24 months when stored according to manufacturers instructions.

Coverage

10m² per litre depending on porosity of substrate.

Disposal of Containers

Do not leave empty containers where residue could be harmful to children, animals or the environment. Replace lids and remove any containers to a central disposal point in accordance with local regulations.
